WHAT DOES STEPS DO?

Outreach and long-term support to Melbourne's homeless youth to help them reconnect into the community.

FOR OUR FUTURE : Staying Connected

We support school-aged children to stay connected to school by assigning them a community mentor and helping them develop a talent or skill, such as learning a musical instrument or playing a sport.

FOR YOU : Education working with youth for youth

We want to let you know we are working hard for your generation and that we believe with your awareness and support we can give our City's kids their hope back.

We publish resources and develop projects with you (secondary school students) exploring and understanding the issues around homelessness - allowing you to respond and develop your own values of social justice. These resources include: 'Under the Bridge', Homelessness Resource Kit, Homelessness Photography Competition and Exhibition.

Steps is about 'giving young people a soft place to fall' by being reliable, persistent and caring and having hope for the young person until they have hope for themselves. **that matters.**
