

Hand Brake Turn - Course Update



For over 20 years **Concern Australia** has successfully delivered the Hand Brake Turn program from various locations across Australia. Our next HBT program intake in **Dandenong** is **30th January 2018 – 15th March 2018**.

Our **7 week automotive training program** offers 3 day per week (Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday - 20 hours) automotive and life skills training for young people between 15 and 21 years of age.

The following prices came into effect on 1st August 2017 –

Learner	Cost
Concession, eligible for Learn Local Funding	\$100
Non-Concession, eligible for Learn Local Funding	\$800 (incl non refundable \$150 admin fee)
Concession, not eligible for Learn Local Funding	\$1,000
Non-Concession, not eligible for Learn Local Funding	\$1,785 (incl non refundable \$150 admin fee)

Note: Where possible, we will access available funding to subsidise the cost of training. Concession eligibility requires evidence of Health Card, Pensioner Card or Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander origin. Please refer to our website for full details: www.concernaustralia.org.au
