
1. STOP BULLYING is a seminar that teaches that bullying can cause serious harm to children's physical, emotional, and mental well-being. We teach children about the harmful effects of bullying can help prevent them from being bullied, as well as encourage them to speak up if they or someone they know is being bullied. We promote empathy and respect for others and that children can learn to appreciate and value differences in people, and to treat others with kindness and fairness. By promoting anti-bullying behaviours, schools can create a safe and positive learning environment where all children can thrive, feel safe and respected, and therefore are more likely to be engaged in learning and social activities.

SEMINAR AIMS:

- 1. To understand the concept of bullying and why it is harmful to themselves and others.
- 2. To teach about the different forms of bullying, such as physical, verbal, and cyberbullying, and how to recognize them.
- 3. To encourage children to speak up if they or someone they know is being bullied, and to seek help from trusted adults.
- 4. To teach strategies for responding to bullying, such as assertiveness, conflict resolution, and empathy.
- 5. To promote positive behaviour and relationships, such as kindness, respect, and inclusion, and to discourage negative behavior, such as teasing, exclusion, and gossip.
